## **A Summary of the June 11, 2018 Palestine ISD Board of Trustees Special Meeting**

The Board of Trustees of the Palestine Independent School District met for Senate Bill 1566 training and a Team of Eight workshop on June 11, 2018 at 5:00 PM, at the Palestine ISD Administrative Offices, 1007 East Park Avenue, Palestine, Texas 75801.

Board of Trustee members and several superintendents from other school districts attended the training in addition to Palestine ISD. (Other school districts included Murchison ISD, Neches ISD, Slocum ISD, and Westwood ISD).

President Sheeley called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM, and each school district with a quorum in attendance called meeting to order for their district.

Marvin Thompson, Region 7 Education Service Center Associate Director for School Operations, presented Senate Bill 1566 Training. (In accordance with Texas Education Code 11.159, school district trustees are required to complete at least 3 hours of training on Evaluating and Improving Student Outcomes (EISO) once every 2 years. The State Board of Education adopted this training requirement in amendments to 19 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) 61.1 on April 13, 2018).

Mr. Thompson also presented a Team Building workshop.

The meeting adjourned at 8:00 PM.
