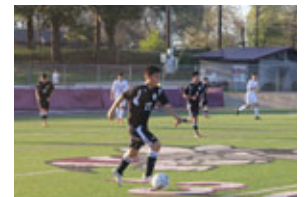
STAAR testing got off to a good start this week. As we prepare for the next round of the STAAR testing coming up on April 20th, encourage students to study hard and get plenty of rest.
